概要 /Summary	<p>We will focus on how the universities can contribute to the reconstruction assistance in the affected areas while the victims acquire resilience - "the ability to cope with a shock" – and nurture it. As the main objective of this IEL, we intend to share with the participants the knowledge obtained after the earthquake, presenting reports of the projects of the University of Tokyo carried out in Otsuchi, Iwate Prefecture, and raising some students' points of view as an example of such contribution efforts by the universities. 感想・ Impressions /Comments	<p>In this IEL, Takashi Suzuki introduced his experiences related with the Great East Japan Earthquake in 2011. Professor Hisashi Kurokura and Mr. Youichi Shintani explained their outcomes of the Otsuchi project.</p> <p>Professor Kurokura presented an overview of Tohoku fishery and concepts of the Otsuchi project. He mentioned that a university is good at making human networks with the outsiders, providing technology and sharing information to foster the affected area's resilience. Furthermore, Mr. Shintani emphasized the importance of academia's role in that it can suggest new style of life/industry. And also he emphasized that it can connect talents of industries. In this point, integrating both top-down approach by government and bottom-up approach by local people should be considered.</p> <p>Our group was able to hold a good opportunity to share information on the Great East Japan Earthquake and its damage to the coastal side of the affected area. Two speakers' presentations were really helpful to understand the possible academia's approach to foster the resilience.</p> <p>In addition, we also provided seafood which was the outcome of the Otsuchi project for the participants to have a chance to experience the value of local resources. This trial event succeeded in making a good mood to conduct a smooth discussion on the situation of the affected area and how to make good use of these kinds of valuable resources.</p>
