Takehiko Kitamori is Yushan Honorary Professor at the National Tsing Hua University, Taiwan, Project Professor at the University of Tokyo, Japan, and Honorary Visiting Professor of Lund University, Sweden. He received his BS degree in the Department of Pure and Applied Science in 1980, and his PhD degree in engineering in 1989, both from the University of Tokyo. He was Vice President after serving as Dean of School of Engineering at The University of Tokyo, and he was responsible for internationalization of entire university. He is the author of more than 300 journal papers and has written more than 50 book chapters. His current research interest includes microfluidics and nanofluidics, applied laser spectroscopy for ultrasensitive detection, femto-liter analytical chemistry, and extended nano space chemistry. He was awarded many honors including Simon-Widmer Award of Swiss Chemical Society. He is Foreign Member of The Royal Swedish Academy of Science, and Honorary Doctor of Lund University.
